

# 2019 CLEE HILLS CLASSIC TRIAL

## ROUTE BOOK FOR CLASSES A-C,7&8

**Route Marking:** Coloured cards are used sparingly to indicate the route:

Red = Right Blue = Left White = Straight-on.

Abbreviations: @ = at PH = Public House Q = Quiet

L = Left R = Right SO = Straight on [sp = Sign Post] T = T Junction X = Crossroads # Fails route rejoins main route at this point.

**Route Alternatives:** To allow for possible adverse weather, 2 sets of 'back up' route alternatives are prepared in this book, ie Ratlinghope Loop and for the Long Mynd. Please check the status of each option after signing on. The alternative routes are on Page 9.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT NOTE</u>: Competitors are earnestly requested to drive with care and restraint especially along the narrow lanes. Although the event is not timed it is important that everything runs roughly to time, therefore competitors are asked not to wait for their friends but to move on to the next section, let them catch you up. Be courteous, and give way to other road users where necessary. *Any* report of bad driving will result in EXCLUSION. The future of Classic Trialling may depend on your high standard of driving.

**Start Lines**: Some sections will have different start lines for different classes. These will be clearly marked with the appropriately coloured disc. If in doubt, ask the start marshal.

**Tyre Pressures**: Motorcycles: NONE

Cars: Different pressure limits apply to different classes at some sections: these are shown in the route book. **Any changes will be posted at the start** 

**Observed Test**: Failure to complete a special test correctly incurs a penalty of 3 points and a time equal to the slowest in the class + 10 seconds.

**Noise Check**: An official noise check may operate at a point around the route.

From start, R out of pub car-park and shortly R onto main road. Immediately L at R'bout onto A49. Continue on A49 following all Shrewsbury signs for approx... 15 Miles through Onibury & Craven Arms to Church Stretton. [Fuel available] At Traffic Lights. Filter L [sp TOWN CENTRE] R at GIVE WAY and in 1 Mile L into obscure road [sp VILLAGE HALL, YHA] CARE & Q. In 0.1 miles, at NO THROUGH **ROAD** sign and yellow grit bin, immediately fork **R** into track:

SNOW ROUTE No 1 STARTS HERE (go to page 9) Proceed to tarmac road. No tyre pressure adjustment until Long Mynd Gliding Club At tarmac road, **L** up hill, with CARE, past brown sign for Jinlye Guest House. Keep **SO** for 1.3 miles over cattle grids. At **X**, **L** [sp HIGH PARK, RATLINGHOPE]. SO for 3.7 miles. Slow over third cattle grid!. On approaching Ratlinghope Church at sharp left turn, by village notice board, R down track [sp NO THROUGH **ROAD**]. Keep off the soft verges. Very slow and **Q** past cottage. **SO** through gate – please CLOSE – to:

'Bikes: From front wheel on Line AA, drive forward to stop astride Line BB (foot to touch the ground), immediately forward to stop astride Line CC

Cars only: From front wheels on Line AA, drive over Line BB, Reverse and stop with all wheels behind Line **BB**. Drive forward and stop astride Line **CC** 

Timed from drop of flag until front wheel(s) cross Line CC

#### A FAIL will be recorded if:-

- Driver/rider starts before drop of flag.
- Car/Rider hits/touches any of the poles at lines AA, BB or CC
- 3 Not completing the test as defined, including over-running line CC
- Rider does not put foot on ground when astride BB

Follow track over hill; at summit keep close to fence on right. Descend carefully to tarmac road closing all gates. At tarmac road **L**, and **immediately R** to Near Gatten. **SO** to

From top of section, follow track down to Far Gatten Farm. Track becomes rutted – CARE down track. CLOSE GATE. **Slow & Q** through farm. **SO** (leave remaining gates open unless advised) to tarmac road where **L**. After 0.7 miles, **L** @ **T**, descend steep hill. **R** @ **T**. **SO** for 2.1 miles, and take 2<sup>nd</sup> left turn, after obscure pale-coloured bungalow on left, uphill [no sp]. Ignore road in from L, **SO** to T where **R** [sp in opposite direction Adstone]. Soon, at start of village, **L** [sp Prolley Moor, Medlicote] and descend 'Dangerous Hill'! **SO** to cross roads:

SNOW ROUTE 2 STARTS HERE (Page 9)

**SO** @ X. Keep L at sharp corner (track in from R) [sp Medlicott] and very soon fork R through gate (PLEASE CLOSE) up track. Continue on track for 1 mile to tarmac road (at car park), where R. After 1.2 miles fork L into Gliding Club entrance. Reduce your tyre pressures here to minimize any damage to the historic Portway track: refer to PRIORS HOLT 4 for tyre pressure limits.

We have special permission to use this track, so please drive very slowly, stop and give way to all other users, whilst also enjoying the views.

Continue **SO** through two gates (please close) and **L** through gate (please close) at **X. SO** through 2<sup>nd</sup> gate (please close) into PRIORS HOLT plantation. This is a BRIDLEWAY. Continue at maximum 15mph. At major cross tracks **R**, following signs to "PH4".

Follow main track through woods / felled trees, CARE - competitors in opposite direction. At next main cross tracks, **R** and follow track downhill through gate (please close), continue down track to:

At end of section turn **R** onto main track (competitors in opposite direction). **SO** passing previous section and return through gate to cross tracks, where **L**, to next major cross tracks where **R** downhill, following "Exit" signs. Bear **R** at junction and continue downhill following "Exit" signs. After long left-hand corner, turn **R** at arrow to:

Immediately after section ends, **keep R** and slowly descend bumpy track (original PH 2). **R** downhill and pass foot of section.

# BRIDLEWAY – 15 MPH max to exit. Continue downhill to exit gates closing both gates. Care – possible two-way traffic. SO @ X to main road where R [No sp] (B4370), downhill for 1.3 miles to T where L [sp CRAVEN ARMS] SO to main A49 where R. In 1 Mile at 3rd mini roundabout L [NB Petrol on Right] onto B4368 [sp Bridgenorth] At end of town and after crossing bridge, L [sp Halford] In 200 yards, R at No Through Road In 1 mile ignore left turn, then keep L at Fork. Return to Forest entrance and **L** at tarmac lane. Continue for 1.8 miles (CARE, competitors in opposite direction) through Lower Dinchope, avoiding both Right junctions follow lane [sp Upper Dinchope, Norton], over hill to B4368 where **L** with Care [sp Bridgnorth B4368] SO for 9 miles. Fuel available in Aston Munslow. keep **R** staying on the B4368 for 10 miles, through Weston, Monkhopton & Aston Eyre to Morville, where **R** onto A458 [sp BRIDGNORTH]. On leaving village, and just before de-restriction sign, fork **R** [sp KINLET, HIGHLEY] and continue for 0.4 miles to CONTROL @ X. Set tyre pressures at control.

When instructed, or if no one at Control, **R** [sp THE LYE, MEADOWLEY, UPTON CRESSETT only]. *GREATEST CARE* and very slow — narrow road with sharp corners, and two-way trials traffic. Continue **SO**, passing "No through road" sign. Keep road clear for local traffic. **SO** to:

# (Care: later competitors in opposite direction), retrace route to **X**, by control, where **L**. In 0.4 miles **L** onto A458 into Morville. **SO** on A458 for 4.7 miles to enter Much Wenlock. Petrol on R. (next petrol 14 miles). Stay on main road around Gaskell Arms hotel, and keep **R** uphill following A458. Half-way down hill, and shortly after bend sign, with CARE, fork **L** onto track to:

With great CARE (fast traffic), turn **R** onto B4371 Continue for 2 miles to Longville At foot of Hill **L** [sp Hopescross; Shipton]. In 3 Miles to **T** where **R** onto main road (B4318) Continue on B4318 for 5.4 Miles passing through Hungerford, Munslow (Petrol on L) and Diddlebury. Pass The Sun Inn on **R**, then fork **L** onto B4365 [sp Ludlow], Over Racecourse to **T** where **L** onto A49 [sp Leominster]. **R** at 2nd R'bout, (by Motorhome sales) [sp Ludlow, Low Bridge] and immediately **L**. Follow road round to the Left into Finish. *READ NEXT PAGE*

### ADVERSE WEATHER 'BACK-UP' ROUTE ALTERNATIVES

#### SNOW ROUE 1: RATLINGHOPE LOOP SNOW BOUND?

YES - AVOID RATLINGHOPE & GATTENS GAMBLE SECTIONS

At the top of Castle Hill section proceed to tarmac road and turn sharp **R** down narrow lane, CARE. Turn **L** at the bottom of the hill onto B5477. **SO** for 1 mile then **R**, crossing bridges over stream then railway and stop at **T** with A49. **R** with CARE – FAST TRAFFIC onto A49. Proceed 4.4 miles to Marshbrook where **R** onto B4370 [sp BISHOPS CASTLE, NEWTOWN and MARSHBROOK BUSINESS PARK] and over level crossing. In 1.2 miles **R** [sp HAMPERLEY, CHURCH MOOR and PRIORS HOLT]. Care, competitors in opposite direction. In 0.4 miles SO [sp CHURCH MOOR, PRIORS HOLT]. **SO** up track into Priors Holt closing both gates. This is a Bridleway – continue at max 15 mph up to summit of hillside, passing Priors Holt Section 1, and bearing **L** @ major junction to continue up hill to cross track where **L**. At next main cross tracks, **R** and follow track downhill through gate (please close) to Priors Holt 4 section on R. Go to page 4 of this route book.

"Snow route" ends.

#### **SNOW ROUTE 2: LONG MYND SNOW BOUND?**

YES – AVOID GLIDING CLUB AND PORTWAY IN APPROACH TO PRIORS HOLT SECTIONS

At cross roads, **TR** and very soon follow road to Left. **SO** for 3.5 miles, where **L** onto A489. **SO** for almost 2 miles, where **L** uphill onto B4370. After 1.4 miles and soon after church on right, and a crest of hill, obscure **L** [sp Hamperley and Priors Holt]. **SO** along narrow lane into Forestry Commission land (Priors Holt), closing both gates. This is a BRIDLEWAY. Continue at maximum 15mph. Follow main track passing "The Slab" and "Priors Holt 1" sections on left. Continue uphill for about 1 mile, bearing **L** at junction. At summit, and at main cross tracks, **L**. At next main cross tracks, **R** and follow track downhill through gate (please close) to Priors Holt 4 section on R. Go to page 4 of this route book.
